P. Daly

P. Daly shared the following with the Committee Members:

i) <u>Article from the Vatican Information Service (VIS) "Catholic Schools,</u> <u>Educating in the Fullness of Humanity</u>"

He expressed his thanks to the Committee members for their commitment to Catholic Education with special thanks to L. Lech for his continued dedication to students.

ii) <u>Ministry Funding</u>

The Board will be receiving funding from the Ministry of Education for the following projects:

- a) Childcare Centre at St. Gabriel Catholic Elementary School
- b) An Addition to St. Jean de Brébeuf Catholic Secondary School
- c) Replacement School for Our Lady of the Assumption Catholic Elementary School

iii) <u>Negotiations</u>

Provincially, agreements have been reached with all the union groups.

Locally, a tentative agreement has been reached with CUPE 3396.

Mr. D. Hansen

Mr. D. Hansen provided updates on the following:

- i) <u>EQAO Results</u>
 - Assessments of Reading, Writing and Mathematics for the primary division (Grades 1-3) and junior division (Grades 4-6)
 - Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics

Provincial results are not available this year due to the teacher work action (non-participation).

Results reveal growth in a number of areas of the assessment and the HWCDSB students continue to perform well in many areas.

Student achievement on the mathematics assessments, at all levels, continues to be an area of concern especially secondary school students at the applied level. The Board continues its commitment on improving the students' success.

ii) <u>CODE Document</u>

D. Hansen shared a document from the Council of Ontario Directors' of Education "Inspiring Your Child to Learn and Love Math". The document was developed to be used as a resource for parent groups, with schools and with their students. The document is available on the CODE website at <u>www.ontariodirectors.ca</u>

iii) <u>Multi-Year Strategic Plan (2015-2018)</u>

D. Hansen reported that the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board is in the process of consulting with all stakeholders in the Catholic Education community with the Board's Multi-Year Strategic Plan (MYSP).

The HWCDSB Multi-Year Plan has three strategic priorities that align with the Board's motto: Believing, Achieving, Serving:

- i) Believing: Strengthening Our Catholicity Nurturing Our Catholic Community
- ii) Achieving: Student Achievement and Well-being
- iii) Serving: Stewardship Effective Management of Resources

Parents, students, parishes, staff, and members of the Catholic community at large have been invited to participate in this process. The Board of Trustees and the Administration of the Board will consider all submissions as the Multi-Year Strategic Plan 2015-2018 is developed.

A Director's Student Forum for both elementary and secondary students will take place on January 7, 2016. The full-day student-led forum is designed to seek student voice that reflects the diversity, needs and interests of our student population on matters essential to the development of the MYSP.

iv) OCSTA Short Video Award Program

Ontario's Catholic school students in grades 4-12 were invited to create 2minute videos demonstrating how their actions of acceptance, love and charity reflect many of the Gospel values that are taught in Ontario's Catholic schools. Almost 100 videos were created.

Cathedral High School received the 1st Place Award in the Secondary Panel. D. Hansen showed the winning video to the Committee.

v) <u>Year of Mercy</u>

Today His Holiness Pope Francis officially opened the doors to the Jubilee Year of Mercy "through which anyone who enters will experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instils hope."
