ITEM 4 REPORTS/DISCUSSION ITEMS

L. Marchionda/N. Centritto

i) <u>Discussion Panel - Parent Involvement Committee (PIC) Symposium</u>

L. Marchionda and N. Centritto were invited to participate in a discussion panel by S. Bortolotti, Educational Officer for the PIC Symposium, via teleconference, on Thursday, March 9th. L. Marchionda was available to participate. Topics discussed included issues parents are encountering and professional learning needs. She reported that the discussion was very productive and informative.

D. Hansen

D. Hansen provided updates on the following:

i) Ontario Autism Program - After School Skills Development Program

The Board submitted a funding proposal in the fall of 2016. The "After School Skills Development Program for Students with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) was developed to provide a meaningful, inclusive after school experience to support individual growth and development.

The after school program will support children with ASD in an engaging and skills-based environment with their classmates and neighbourhood peers. The program will be fully integrated and align with the existing after school program (outdoor physical literacy, snack, creative exploration, and socialization).

The program will be offered at six school sites and have the capacity to support a maximum addition of 16 students identified with ASD at one time.

The Board was approved for \$735,002 in funding for two years.

ii) EQAO Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test

Thursday, March 30, 2017, is the date that all secondary schools in the province are scheduled to administer the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test. This Board will be participating.

iii) Graduation Rate Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board

D. Hansen led the Committee through the report presented to the Board of Trustees on February 21, 2017. He noted that the graduation rate is a key indicator of student success within a school board and an important assessment of the implementation of the Board's Multi-Year Strategic Plan and the Board Improvement Plan for Student Achievement.

The report addressed the graduation rate for students over the last five years representing a graduation rate of 89%.

iv) Robotics Teams

D. Hansen shared the following with the Committee:

- St. Mary's MakeShift Robotics Team won the Chairman's Award at the Victoria Park Collegiate FRC District Competition in Scarborough on March 19th and will be participating in the FIRST Robotics Provincial Competition in Mississauga on April 12th-14th;
- Bishop Ryan Celt-X Team won two awards at the Victoria Park Collegiate FRC District Competition in Scarborough on March 19th -- the Engineering Inspiration and Industrial Design Award;
- BR Celt-X Team had a district win at Georgian College in Barrie on March 24-26th;
- Bishop Tonnos' Robotics Team advanced to the semi-final round at the Waterloo district regional qualifier against veteran team Orchard Park and were recognized with Waterloo's Rookie Inspiration Award; and
- Cardinal Newman Robotics Team made it to the final-quarter round at Georgian College before being eliminated.

The four teams are set to compete at McMaster University FRC District Competition on April 1st.
