P. Daly provided updates on the following:

## i) An Education Equity Plan – Ministry of Education

Mr. Daly noted that the following could lead to profound change to the provision of publicly funded education in Ontario:

- a consultation with regard to curriculum, new Report Cards, EQAO and a consultation with regards to Education Governance;
- a draft plan re: Improving Well-being for Students across Ontario

#### ii) Executive Compensation

The Executive Compensation Framework Regulation (September 2016), established under the Broader Public Sector Executive Compensation Act, 2014 (BPSECA), sets out requirements that designated broader public sector (BPS) employers must meet when establishing executive compensation programs.

The Ministry of Education is now considering the proposed executive compensation framework for all 72 publicly-funded school boards to use for the development of their own local executive compensation program as required by the BPSECA and its regulations and directives.

The Board will be subject to a 30-day public consultation including the posting of the philosophy and details of the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board Executive Compensation Program on the Board's web-site.

# D. Hansen provided updates on the following:

#### i) EQAO Results 2016-2017

- Assessments of Reading, Writing and Mathematics for the primary division (Grades 1-3) and junior division (Grades 4-6)
- Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics

Results demonstrate high achievement and continued growth in a number of areas of the assessment and the HWCDSB students.

Student achievement on the mathematics assessments, at all levels, continues to be an area of concern. The Board continues its commitment on improving the students' success.

a) NTIP – 96 new teachers were hired since September 2016

# b) Physical Activity and Healthy Living (PAHL) Sports Day

This year's PAHL Day was October 4<sup>th</sup> at Bishop Ryan Catholic Secondary School. This is a day when students of all skill levels and abilities are encouraged to participate in a variety of activities. These activities include basketball, soccer, curling, floor hockey, baseball and golf. The event is open to secondary school students with special needs and peer mentors. Each student attending this event was provided with an opportunity to try activities that promote physical activity and encourage incorporating physical activity into daily living.

The Ministry of Education is engaging with its education partners on several governance topics to identify and support effective practices that strengthen Board governance.
