N. Centritto/D. Eberts

D. Eberts attended the OAPCE Symposium in November. She noted that it was a positive experience and a great opportunity to network with other parents.

P. Daly

P. Daly provided updates on the following:

i) Consultation: Education in Ontario

The Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association submission dated November 2018 was distributed for the Committee's information. P. Daly highlighted his letter to Mayor Eisenberger and Members of Hamilton City Council dated November 21, 2018 re: the Board's concerns regarding Cannabis Store locations and buffer zones to schools.

ii) Provincial Funding

P. Daly provided an update on the Ministry of Education 2019-2020 Grants for Student Needs (GSN) consultation. He noted the reference in the consultation guide of the government's intention to realize "Four cents on the dollar" in efficiencies/savings.

iii) New Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board of Trustees

At the Inaugural Meeting of the Board on December 4, 2018, nine members, including two newly elected Trustees Louis Agro and Phil Homerski, were sworn in.

He provided updates on the following:

i) Math Special Assignment Teacher (MSAT) Strategy

The Board has seven MSATs that are assigned four schools each. They visit each school on the same day each week for the entire day.

The MSATs provide job-embedded professional learning for individual educators, groups, division and/or whole school based on urgent student needs in Mathematics.

ii) Board Improvement Plan for Student Achievement (BIPSA) 2018-2019

Participation date was shared with the Committee for their information. Goals, Strategies, Monitoring and Data Sources and Indicators of Success were highlighted.

iii) Physical Literacy Update: Elementary Schools

Working with schools and teachers re physical literacy. Three areas of focus include:

- Building Teacher Capacity through the Ontario Physical Literacy Summit - Ninety-eight staff of the HWCDSB attended the Annual Ontario Physical Literacy Summit held on September 21, 2018 at Redeemer University and Immaculate Conception Catholic Elementary School;
- Hamilton Moves Project - The HWCDSB has partnered with Rising Stars in the second year of a three-year project to implement the "Hamilton Moves" initiative in all 48 elementary schools. The goal of this partnership is to build teacher capacity in the delivery of essential Fundamental Movement Skills (FMS) during physical education classes.

- The Recess Project - In year one of the Hamilton Moves Project, 288 training workshops took place at 42 schools targeting Primary Planning Teachers. A total of 3570 Grade 1, 2, and 3 students received Physical Literacy training from Rising Stars
