S.E.01 Out-of-School Learning Experiences

Policy Statement

The Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board recognizes and encourages the educational value of learning experiences in the world beyond the classroom and acknowledges that out-of-school learning experiences should be an integral part of every student's program of studies.

Purpose

It is expected that all out-of-school learning experiences be directed toward an educational purpose and that evidence of effective program planning and preparation must be part of the approval process.

Responsibility

Principals, staff and parents, shall consult and follow the Out-of-School Learning Experiences Guidelines and Procedures document. The principal of each school will ensure that all forms and procedures are followed. The Superintendent of Education for each family of schools will give final approval for all overnight and out-of-province out-of-school learning experiences.
